

NANCY GOSHOW ATTENDS SENATE MEETING ON FEDERAL CONTRACTING LEGISLATION

On October 29th, Nancy Goshow and other members and coalition partners of Women Impacting Public Policy's (WIPP) Procurement Committee met with Greg Willis, Counsel for the Senate Committee on Small Business and Entrepreneurship. The group discussed federal contracting and recommendations for legislation, which will be introduced later this year.
